#### Monday with Mikey: May 8, 2017

During our recent holiday to Spain, FMJ (First Mate Jocelyn) and I had occasion to pass through the city of La Mancha, local capital of the province of the same name. My thoughts turned then, as they do now, to the story of Don Quixote, a "hidalgo" (a nobleman without an official title) and his "noble squire" Sancho Panza, a farmer that Don Q. convinces to follow him on his quest to right wrongs – real or perceived – in the world as he knew it.

The book, written by Miguel de Cervantes Saadvera, is titled (English translation) The history of the valorous and wittie Knight-Errant Don-Quixote of the Mancha, was first published in two volumes. The first was is 1605 and the second was in 1615 – and collectively they have been called the original modern novel, a nihilistic dark satire of the institutions of the day, and an inspired comment on the need for purity and virtue in the world.

It was required reading in Mrs. Scott's eight-grade English class. It was pretty confusing to me then, but as the years have gone by and I have (hopefully) developed insight through experience – much as don Quixote did – I find it a poignant, timeless, universal comment on everything from true religion, to one's own quest (jihad?), to the truth that lies behind humor.

In 1965, Man of La Mancha opened on Broadway. The overarching theme of the book was encapsulated in the song The Impossible Dream, and I offer them to you as this week's "thought provoking poem." As always, please forgive the "single-gender" nature of the lyrics.

To dream the impossible dream, to fight the unbeatable foe,

To bear with unbearable sorrow, to run where the brave dare not go,

To right the unrightable wrong, to love - pure and chaste - from afar,

To try when your arms are too weary, to reach the unreachable star:

This is my quest: to follow that star - no matter how hopeless, no matter how far;

To fight for the right without question or pause; to be willing to march into Hell for a Heavenly Cause!

And I know, if I'll only be true to this glorious quest, that my heart will lie peaceful and calm when I'm laid to my rest.

And the world will be better for this: that one man, scorned and covered with scars Still strove with his last ounce of courage To reach the unreachable star!
